Government Book Scheme 2023

The Board of Management of St. Martin de Porres National School welcomes the Government's initiative to provide free schoolbooks, workbooks and copybooks to all pupils from September 2023. All books and copybooks will be in the child's classroom on return to school. The schoolbooks and workbooks will be on loan to the children. They must be returned at the end of the school year, or if the child leaves the school. It is important that books are kept in good condition. If any parents wish to leave their child's current school books not including workbooks in the school for reuse and recycling this would be very much welcomed

While this is a welcome initiative the school will have to charge a fee of €50.00 per pupil to cover the cost of photocopying, art & craft, school journal and IT licenses. Junior and Senior Infants fees are slightly higher at of €60.00 due to additional supplies used at this class level.
